







| <p><b>Global rating agency Moody’s flags concerns about India’s Aadhaar</b></p> <p><b>Aadhaar</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Aadhaar is a 12-digit unique identification number issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI).</li> <li>It serves as proof of identity, which is linked to the individual's biometric and demographic information.</li> <li>It is now mandatory for a number of government services</li> </ul> | <p><b>In news:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Global rating agency Moody’s Investors Service has flagged concerns about security and privacy vulnerabilities in centralised identification systems such as India’s Aadhaar programme.</li> </ul>  <p><b>Key points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>According to them the unique ID system often results in “service denials” in humid conditions and the biometric is also unreliable at that time.</li> <li>It also faces the burden of establishing authorisation.</li> <li>This can lead to Aadhaar-based payments problems for labourers.</li> </ul> <p><b>Did you know?</b><br/>It is the world's largest digital program that is helping in covering the leakages in transfer of subsidy.</p>  |
| <p><b>Parliamentary panel on NEP</b></p>  | <p><b>Context</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education, <b>headed by MP Vivek Thakur</b> has tabled a report in parliament.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key suggestions of panel</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The panel suggested that by 2030, every district in the country should have at least <b>one multidisciplinary Higher Education Institutes( HEI)</b></li> <li>The <b>Gross Enrolment Ratio</b> in higher education, including vocational education, <b>should be increased from 26.3% in 2018 to 50% by 2035.</b></li> <li>Allocation of suitable funds for the education of Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs).</li> <li>Improving the effectiveness and impact of the <b>Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) in funding HEIs</b></li> <li>The panel also suggested that the <b>multiple entry, multiple exit may not suitable for india</b></li> </ul> |

| <p><b>Genome sequencing</b></p>  | <p><b>About genome sequencing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Genome sequencing is <b>figuring out the order of DNA nucleotides</b>, or bases, in a genome.</li> <li>● It has the order of <b>Adenine, Cytosine, Guanine, and Thymine</b> that make up an organism's DNA.</li> <li>● It is <b>the process that involves deciphering the exact order of base pairs in an individual</b>. This “deciphering” or reading of the genome is what sequencing is all about.</li> </ul> <p><b>Advantages</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Early diagnostic and targeted treatment of disease</li> <li>● Genetic risk of developing disease can be detected earlier helps manage inherited disease</li> <li>● It can guide specific lifestyle changes and can prevent the appearance of certain diseases.</li> </ul> |

**ESIC:**

- It is **set up under the Employee State Insurance Act of 1948.**
- It is responsible for overseeing the ESI plan.
- It works **under the Ministry of Labour & Employment**
- Its **aim is to provide socio-economic protection to the worker population** and immediate dependent or family covered under the ESI scheme.

Key Points:

- It recognizes and honors individuals and organizations for their outstanding contributions to the field of public health.
- The award was **instituted in 2014**

It is given in two categories:

1. **Individual:** Given to individuals who have made significant contributions to public health through their research, advocacy, or implementation of innovative programs.
2. **Organization:** Given to organizations that have made significant contributions to public health through service delivery, research, or advocacy.

'Back to School' campaign

In News:

The Kudumbashree mission of Ernakulam district in association with the general education department has decided to hold a campaign.

Key facts
