
Context

The Union government's scheme to provide 5 kg of free food grains every month to **80 crore Indians**, which is slated to end this December, will be extended for another five years.

Key points

- The Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) was introduced in 2020 as a pandemic relief measure, providing 5 kg of free foodgrains per beneficiary a month in addition to the 5 kg of subsidized foodgrains they were entitled to under the National Food Security Act.
- This is now being extended to another 5 years.

De-induction of the IL-38



Context

- The de-induction of the IL-38 aircraft was done recently.
- C-295 aircraft in the **medium-range maritime** patrol aircraft (MPA) can take its role in the future

About IL-38

- IL-38 is a maritime reconnaissance aircraft that was commissioned into the Indian Navy in 1977 and remained a formidable air asset throughout its service life for nearly 44 years.
- It was with the induction of IL 38 aircraft that the Navy moved into the arena of airborne Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance (LRMR) combined with long-range anti-submarine search and strike, anti-shipping strike, electronic signal intelligence, and distant SAR.
- The IL 38 is an all-weather aircraft with long endurance and substantial operating range. Having clocked nearly 10,000 hours of operational flying.

India is set to open a new consulate in Seattle

Context

- The Ministry of External Affairs has appointed its first Consul-General in the U.S. city, Seattle.
- This will be the sixth consulate in the U.S.

About Zika Virus

- It is a mosquito-borne virus that was first identified in the Zika Forest of Uganda in 1947.
- It is primarily transmitted to humans through the bite of infected Aedes mosquitoes, particularly Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus.
- It can also spread through sexual contact, blood transfusion, and from an infected mother to her baby during pregnancy or childbirth.
- This virus infection is usually mild, it can have serious consequences for pregnant women and their babies.
- Infection during pregnancy can lead to birth defects such as microcephaly, as well as other neurological disorders in the baby.
- It has also been linked to **Guillain-Barré syndrome**, a rare autoimmune disorder that can lead to muscle weakness and paralysis.
- **Treatment:** There is no specific treatment available for Zika virus infection or disease.

NCERT to introduce electoral literacy content in textbooks



Context

In a bid to address voter apathy among young Indians, the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) will introduce and update textbooks to include content on electoral literacy

Key points

- The measures are part of a memorandum of understanding signed by the Election Commission of India (EC) and the Education Ministry.
- It is aimed at extending the EC's flagship Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) in schools and colleges.
- The MoU aims to address issues such as voter apathy among urban and young Indians.

Key Points:

 The book's narration begins by breaking down kathakali into its basic components of 'Katha' (story) and 'kali' (performance) so that children can understand that it is a game of storytelling," says Namboodiri, who was conferred the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award in 2013.

About Kathakali:

- Kathakali is a traditional dance-drama form that originated in Kerala, India.
- It is known for its elaborate costumes, stylized makeup, and symbolic hand gestures.
- Kathakali stories are typically based on Hindu mythology, epics, and folktales.

Kathakali performances are typically divided into three parts:

- The **first part** is the introduction, or **"pooja"**. It is a ritualistic offering to the gods and goddesses.
- The second part is the main story. This is where the dancers enact the story through dance, music, and dialogue.
- The **third part** is the conclusion, or **"epilogue"**. This is where the dancers summarize the story and leave the audience with a moral lesson.
