<p>Kerala's Wild Elephant Population Decline:Survey</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A recent survey detected a significant decline in Kerala's wild elephant population.• Last year's survey by the Forest Department recorded 1,920 elephants, which has now been reduced to 1,793. <p>Key findings of Survey:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Forest Department attributes this decline to elephants migrating to forest areas in neighboring states.• Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary has the highest number of elephants (813), followed by Anamudi (615).• Nilambur has 198 elephants, while Wayanad has 78.• There has been a 29% decrease in Wayanad and a 12% reduction in Anamudi, primarily due to climate change. <p>Mortality Rates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• From 2015 to 2023, 845 wild elephants died, with an increasing number each year.• Young elephants under the age of ten are most prone to death according to the surveys.

Thiruvananthapuram International Airport

Context:

- Thiruvananthapuram International Airport (TVM) will introduce robots for cleaning, marking a pioneering step in India's adoption of robotic technology.
- This initiative could potentially be the first of its kind for Indian airports.

Key points:

- These robots are specially designed to clean sludge and waste in large, industrial confined spaces.
- They are being recognized as the world's first robotic scavengers.

Passenger Traffic Growth:

- Thiruvananthapuram International Airport (TRV) saw a notable increase in passenger traffic during the first quarter of 2024-25.
- Total passenger count for this period reached over 1.26 million, a 21% rise from the 1.038 million passengers in Q1 2023-24.

Air Traffic Movements (ATMs):

- In Q1 FY2024-25, TRV recorded 7,954 ATMs, a 14% increase from the 6,887 ATMs in Q1 2023-24.

About:

- Established in 1932, it is the first airport in the state of Kerala.
- Thiruvananthapuram International Airport , is the second busiest airport in Kerala and the fourteenth busiest in India.

<p>Jalagamrudhi</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Officially commenced in 2017, Jalagamrudhi is a significant water conservation initiative in Kerala's Kattakada assembly constituency. • The project addresses escalating climate challenges and declining groundwater reserves in the region. <p>Achievements and Impact:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The community-based programme effectively halted the acute water scarcity experienced for the past two decades. • Groundwater levels saw a substantial increase, from 1,355 million cubic meters (mcm) to 4,908.68 mcm between 2017 and 2019. <p>Initiation and Implementation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Initiated by MLA I B Sathesh post his 2016 election, the project exemplifies local planning combined with government cooperation. • The initiative involved cleaning 314 ponds and over 43,000 wells, digging more than 300 farm ponds, and installing recharging structures in government institutions and schools.
