Waqf (Amendment) Bill	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>Kerala aims to present a unified stance in opposition to the Waqf (Amendment) Bill, seeking to articulate a collective voice against the proposed legislation.</li> <li>The Bill proposes major changes to the Waqf Act 1995, by introducing sweeping changes in the governance and regulation of Waqfs in India.</li> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>A waqf, also known as habs or mortmain property, is an inalienable charitable endowment established under Islamic law. It is a personal property given by Muslims for a specific purpose—religious, charitable, or for private purposes.</li> <li>The Waqf can be formed through a deed, or Instrument, or even orally.</li> <li>The Central Waqf Act, 1954 was enacted after independence to provide for the regulation of Waqfs. This act was ultimately replaced by the Waqf Act, 1995.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Key Points:         <ul> <li>Avian influenza, often referred to as bird flu, is a highly contagious viral infection that primarily affects birds, particularly wild birds and domestic poultry.</li> <li>In 1996, highly pathogenic avian influenza H5N1 virus was first identified in domestic waterfowl in Southern China. The virus is named A/goose/Guangdong/1/1996.</li> <li>Human cases of H5N1 avian influenza occur occasionally, but it is difficult to transmit the infection from person to person.</li> <li>When people become infected, the mortality rate is about 60%.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Kavach System	Why in news?  • Ernakulam-Shoranur rail corridor to get 'Kavach' safety cover in three years.
	<ul> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>It is an indigenously developed Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system.</li> <li>Kavach was developed by the Research Design and Standards Organisation (RDSO) under Indian Railway (IR) in collaboration with Medha Servo Drives Pvt Ltd, HBL Power Systems Ltd and Kernex Microsystems.</li> <li>It is a set of electronic devices and Radio Frequency Identification devices installed in locomotives, in the signaling system as well the tracks, that talk to each other using ultra-high radio frequencies to control the brakes of trains and also alert drivers, all based on the logic programmed into them.</li> </ul>
