kerala govt urges World Bank to relax rules	<ul> <li>Amid growing concern over the slow progress of the Kerala State Waste Management Project (KSWMP), the state government has urged the World Bank to relax its stringent guidelines and make them more adaptable considering the unique circumstances of the state.</li> <li>The Rs 2,400-crore project, launched in 2021, aims to improve solid waste management in 93 urban local bodies across Kerala.</li> <li>However, the World Bank has rated its progress as 'moderately unsatisfactory' in terms of overall implementation pace, project management and project development objectives.</li> </ul>
	Data:  ■ Around 40% of the Bank grant as part of the initiative has already been allotted to 93 local bodies based on the population, while the rest is allotted as incentives.
