Kerala's first seaplane successfully lands at Bolgatty Lake	<ul> <li>Kerala's first seaplane, a De Havilland Canada DHC-6 Twin Otter, successfully landed at Bolgatty Lake, located on the city side of Kochi, on November 10, 2024.</li> <li>This event marks a significant milestone in the development of seaplane tourism in Kerala, with the potential to revolutionise the way travellers experience the state's beautiful backwaters and coastal destinations.</li> <li>This successful trial run is a precursor to the launch of commercial seaplane services, which are expected to commence on November 11, 2024.</li> <li>The initial route will connect Kochi with Mattupetti, a popular hill station in Kerala.</li> </ul>	
India's first fully solar-powered dairy	<ul> <li>Ernakulam Milma, a prominent dairy cooperative in Kerala, has achieved a significant milestone by becoming the country's first fully solar-powered dairy.</li> <li>This achievement was made possible by the installation of a 2 MW solar power plant at their Tripunithura facility.</li> <li>This initiative not only reduces their reliance on traditional energy sources but also significantly lowers their carbon footprint, promoting sustainable practices in the dairy industry.</li> </ul>	
Technopark-based firm in Kerala to launch its satellite	<ul> <li>A Technopark-based startup, HEX20, is set to make history by becoming the first Kerala-based company to partner with SpaceX for a satellite launch.</li> <li>Their maiden satellite, "Nila," named after the Nila river and the Technopark building, will be launched on SpaceX's Transporter-13 mission in February 2025.</li> <li>This mission marks HEX20's entry into the hosted payload market, a key service area for the startup.</li> <li>About:         <ul> <li>Nila" will carry a payload for in-orbit demonstration from a German company, DCubed.</li> <li>It is a 3U satellite weighing under 5kg and will be sent to low earth orbit (LEO).</li> <li>HEX20 plans to set up a ground station at Marian College of Engineering in Menamkulam to manage satellite command and control.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
