	About: ■ The SilverLine project is a proposed semi-high-speed rail line in India that would connect Thiruvananthapuram, the capital city, and Kasaragod of Kerala state.
	 Key Points: Route: The 529.45 km line will connect Thiruvananthapuram to Kasaragod, covering 11 districts through 11 stations. Speed: Trains will run at a maximum speed of 200 km/h, reducing travel time from 12 hours to less than 4 hours.
	Benefits: Reduced travel time and improved connectivity. Reduced road congestion and accidents. Boost to tourism and economic development. Environmentally friendly mode of transport.
	 Challenges: Land acquisition: Requires acquiring 1,200 hectares of land, facing resistance from landowners and environmentalists.
