<p>24-hour online court opens in Kollam district</p>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Kerala's Kollam district has made history by launching India's first 24-hour online court.</li> <li>● This groundbreaking initiative aims to reduce the backlog of cases and expedite legal solutions.</li> <li>● The court operates on a hybrid mode, allowing for both online and in-person proceedings</li> <li>● Initially, it will focus on cases related to check dishonor under <b>Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.</b></li> <li>● This innovative approach is set to revolutionize access to justice in India.</li> </ul>
<p>Vizhinjam seaport</p>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The Kerala government has allocated ₹1000 crore for the acquisition of land for the Vizhinjam Development Zone.</li> <li>● The project will cover an area of approximately 200 acres.</li> <li>● The land acquisition will be carried out by the Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB).</li> <li>● The project will include a new seaport, a container terminal, a logistics hub, and a residential area.</li> <li>● The project is expected to generate employment for thousands of people.</li> </ul> <p><b>About:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Location:</b> Vizhinjam, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.</li> <li>● <b>Purpose:</b> Designed for container transshipment, multi-purpose cargo, and break bulk cargo</li> <li>● <b>Development:</b> Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model with Adani Vizhinjam Port Private Limited as the concessionaire</li> <li>● <b>Strategic Location:</b> Located 10 nautical miles from the busy international shipping route connecting Europe, the Persian Gulf, and the Far East</li> </ul> <p><b>Advantages:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Natural draft of 20-24 meters</li> <li>● Minimal littoral drift</li> <li>● Large-scale automation for quick vessel turnaround</li> <li>● State-of-the-art infrastructure for handling Megamax containerships</li> <li>● Capacity: Phase 1 capacity of 1 million TEUs, with potential for expansion to 6.2 million TEUs in subsequent phases.</li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The World Fisheries Day celebration and Sea Rights Declaration will take place on Nov 21, emphasizing the slogan 'The sea and its resources belong to the coastal community.'</b></li> <li>• The event is jointly organized by the Coastal Students Cultural Forum and Kerala Independent Fish Workers Federation at Puthiyathura beach.</li> </ul> <p><b>About:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>World Fisheries Day is celebrated on November 21st</b> each year to raise awareness about the importance of fisheries and aquaculture.</li> <li>• It was <b>established in 1997 at the World Forum of Fish Harvesters and Fish Workers in New Delhi.</b></li> <li>• The day aims to highlight the significant role of fisheries in providing food, nutrition, and income to millions of people worldwide.</li> <li>• It also emphasizes the need for sustainable fishing practices to ensure the long-term health of our oceans and fisheries.</li> </ul> <p><b>Theme:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>World Fisheries Day 2024 theme is "India's Blue Transformation: Strengthening Small-Scale and Sustainable Fisheries".</b></li> <li>• This theme emphasizes the importance of small-scale fisheries in sustainable fisheries management and their contribution to local food security and livelihoods</li> </ul>
<b>Hemophilia</b>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kerala has become a pioneer in hemophilia care in India by offering a costly but effective monoclonal antibody treatment to patients.</li> <li>• This treatment, which is not available in many other states, has significantly improved the quality of life for hemophilia patients in Kerala.</li> <li>• The monoclonal antibody treatment is a preventive therapy that helps to reduce the frequency and severity of bleeding episodes.</li> </ul> <p><b>About:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Hemophilia is a rare inherited bleeding disorder that impairs the body's ability to clot blood.</b></li> <li>• This occurs due to a deficiency in specific clotting factors, essential proteins in the blood that help form clots.</li> <li>• <b>Types of Haemophilia:</b></li> <li>• <b>Hemophilia A:</b> The most common type, caused by a deficiency in <b>clotting factor VIII.</b></li> <li>• <b>Hemophilia B:</b> Less common, caused by a deficiency in <b>clotting factor IX</b></li> </ul>



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
