SilverLine project	 Context: The Southern Railway has requested a revision of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the ambitious SilverLine project. - **Development**: **Public-Private Partnership (PPP)** model with Adani Vizhinjam Port Private Limited as the concessionaire
- Strategic Location: Located 10 nautical miles from the busy international shipping route connecting Europe, the Persian Gulf, and the Far East

Advantages:

- Natural draft of 20-24 meters
- Minimal littoral drift
- Large-scale automation for quick vessel turnaround
- State-of-the-art infrastructure for handling Megamax containerships
- Capacity: **Phase 1 capacity of 1 million TEUs**, with potential for expansion to 6.2 million TEUs in subsequent phases.
