	 Key points: Every year, there is a clamor for seats under the Right to Education (RTE) Act with lakhs applying for free admission in private schools. This year, nearly 19,000 seats under the 25% scheme are vacant in Maharashtra even though 3.64 lakh applications were received by the state education department for the 1.01 lakh seats. Education officials said that the vacant seats were in non-popular schools and with government schools also providing quality education, many preferred to study there.
