<p><b>Bhutan and China make progress in border talks</b></p> 	<p><b>Context</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Chinese Foreign Minister <b>Wang Yi</b> met Bhutanese Foreign Minister <b>Tandi Dorji</b>.</li> <li>25th round of discussions was held recently (previous round was held in 2016)</li> <li>Beijing pushes for diplomatic ties with Thimphu</li> <li>Both sides want a deal on <b>demarcating the boundaries</b> “soon”.</li> </ul> <p><b>Impact on India</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any deal between China and Bhutan that accedes to a “swap arrangement” between <b>areas to the north (Jamparlung and Pasamlung valleys) with Doklam to the west</b> would be of concern to India, given the proximity to India’s narrow “<b>Siliguri corridor</b>” that connects the northeastern States with the rest of India.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b></p> <p>The Centre has asked all departments to deploy officers to showcase its achievements across the country down to the village level, through a roadshow titled <b>Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra</b></p> <p><b>Key points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The yatra will <b>publicize the government’s welfare schemes</b> across the country and is targeted at the “lower middle class”.</li> <li>It is scheduled from <b>November 20 to January 26</b>.</li> </ul>

### eSIM card

#### Context

- Over the years, the SIM card has shrunk from the SIM to the mini SIM to the micro SIM to the nano SIM.
- The latest on this path is the eSIM, with specifications defined by the **Global System for Mobile Communications (GSM) Association**

#### Key points

- 'SIM' stands for '**subscriber identification module**'.
- Specifically, it is an integrated circuit, or a microchip, that identifies the subscriber on a given network.
- In the eSIM paradigm, the SIM software is loaded on to a UICC that is permanently installed in the mobile equipment in the factory itself, that it can't be removed. **(This is called the eUICC.)**

#### Advantages of eSim

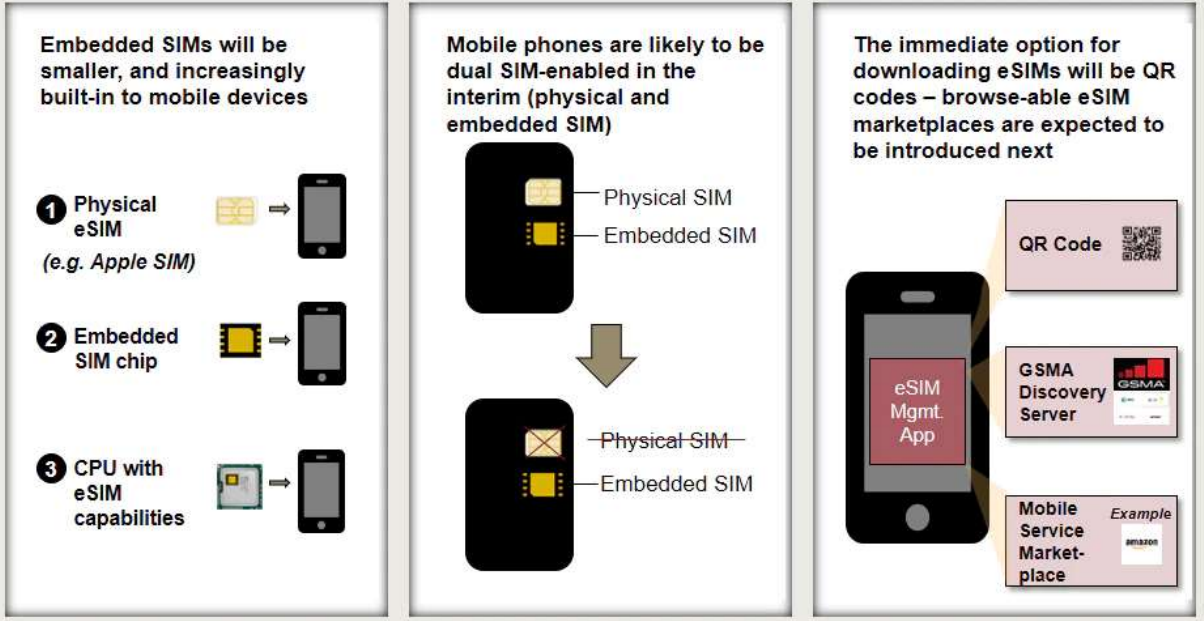
- It is considered to be **environmentally friendlier than a physical SIM**: its reprogrammability means no need for more plastic and metal for a new SIM.
- If a malicious person gains access to your phone, they won't be able to separately access the SIM application nor be able to duplicate it.

#### Disadvantages of eSim

- In some countries, including the U.S., eSIMs can be programmed by subscribers themselves. But this process might be **difficult for those with low digital literacy**, such as the elderly.
- An eSIM can in theory **allow network operators to track subscribers' data**, including inside apps on the device, especially in the absence of data privacy laws.

<p><b>DNA and face-matching systems at police stations</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b> The Centre is all set to roll out “<b>DNA and face-matching</b>” systems at 1,300 police stations across the country.</p> <p><b>Key points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● It will be implemented under the <b>Criminal Procedure Identification Act</b> which was passed last year.</li><li>● The law enables police and Central investigating agencies to collect, store, and analyse physical and biological samples, including retina and iris scan of arrested persons.</li><li>● <b>NCRB</b> is to prepare the SOPs</li></ul>
<p><b>National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● NCRB was <b>set-up in 1986</b> to function as a repository of information on crime and criminals to assist the investigators in linking crime to the perpetrators.</li><li>● It was recommended by <b>Tandon Committee, National Police Commission (1977-1981) and the MHA’s Task force (1985)</b>.</li><li>● NCRB is entrusted with the responsibility for monitoring, coordinating, and implementing the <b>Crime and Criminal Tracking Network &amp; Systems (CCTNS) project</b>.</li><li>● It is headquartered in <b>New Delhi</b> and is part of the <b>Ministry of Home Affairs</b>.</li><li>● Its publications include:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Accidental Deaths &amp; Suicides in India</li><li>b. Prison Statistics India</li><li>c. Fingerprints in India</li><li>d. Report on missing women and children in India</li></ol></li></ul>

<p><b>Food labels to have QR code</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has recommended the <b>use of quick response (QR) codes</b> on food products for accessibility by persons with visual disabilities</li><li>• This would ensure access to safe food for all, including those with special needs.</li></ul> <p><b>About FSSAI</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• It is a statutory body established under the <b>Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 (FSS Act)</b>.</li><li>• FSS Act, of 2006 consolidated various acts &amp; orders that had earlier handled food-related issues in various Ministries and Departments.</li><li>• Nodal ministry: <b>Ministry of Health &amp; Family Welfare</b></li></ul>
<p><b>Sri Lanka announces free visas for Indians</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b></p> <p>Sri Lanka waived visa fee for Indians and tourists from six other countries, as part of its <b>efforts to boost tourist arrivals</b> and help rebuild the island nation's battered economy</p> <p><b>Key points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• India has remained Sri Lanka's top source market for many years. This year, over <b>2 lakh Indian tourists — constituting 20 % of the total tourist arrivals</b> — have visited the island nation until September 2023.</li><li>• The Cabinet announced implementation of a pilot project to issue free tourist visas to tourists from China, India, Russia, Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, and Japan until March 31, 2024.</li></ul>
