1. Burnish (verb)

Meaning; To make smooth or shiny by rubbing; to polish; to shine.



- **synonyms:** brighten, shine
- antonyms: tarnish, dull
- Sentence Example: Burnished the floor of the ballroom to a soft luster.
- Verb (Definition): Verbs are words that show an action (sing), occurrence (develop), or state of being (exist).

2. Joust (noun)

Meaning; To engage in mock combat or To engage in verbal sparring over an important issue



synonyms: contestantonyms: support

- Sentence Example: The knights *jousted* against each other.
- **Noun (Definition):** *Nouns* make up the largest class of words in most languages, including English. A noun is a word that refers to a thing (book), a person (Noah Webster), an animal (cat), a place (Omaha), a quality (softness), an idea (justice), or an action (yodeling).

3. Proffer (verb) Meaning; An offer made



- Synonyms: propose, offer
- Antonyms: reject, deny
- Sentence Example: He *proffered* advice on how best to proceed.
- Verb (Definition): Verbs are words that show an action (sing), occurrence (develop), or state of being (exist).

4. Corroborate (verb)

Meaning; To confirm or support something with additional evidence



- Synonyms: verify, validate
- Antonyms: reject, ignore
- Sentence Example: He witnesses *corroborated* the policeman's testimony.
