

## Daily English Vocab 29 April 2024

### 1. Burnish (verb)

**Meaning;** To make smooth or shiny by rubbing; to polish; to shine.



- **synonyms:** brighten, shine
- **antonyms:** tarnish, dull
- **Sentence Example:** *Burnished* the floor of the ballroom to a soft luster.
- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).

### 2. Joust (noun)

**Meaning;** To engage in mock combat or To engage in verbal sparring over an important issue



- **synonyms:** contest
- **antonyms:** support

- **Sentence Example:** The knights *jousted* against each other.
- **Noun (Definition):** *Nouns* make up the largest class of words in most languages, including English. A noun is a word that refers to a thing (*book*), a person (*Noah Webster*), an animal (*cat*), a place (*Omaha*), a quality (*softness*), an idea (*justice*), or an action (*yodeling*).

### 3. Proffer (verb)

**Meaning;** An offer made



- **Synonyms:** propose, offer
- **Antonyms:** reject, deny
- **Sentence Example:** He *proffered* advice on how best to proceed.
- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).

### 4. Corroborate (verb)

**Meaning;** To confirm or support something with additional evidence



- **Synonyms:** verify, validate
- **Antonyms:** reject, ignore
- **Sentence Example:** He witnesses *corroborated* the policeman's testimony.

- **Verb (Definition):** *Verbs* are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).
