| <p>Regional Analysis of Indian Ocean (RAIN)</p> | <p>Why in the news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS) has recently upgraded its Regional Analysis of Indian Ocean (RAIN) system to enhance the collection of information on the health of the Indian Ocean. <p>About RAIN:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Developed by: Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS).• Previous Version: Utilized only salinity and sea surface temperature.• Upgraded Version: Now includes sea surface height and Sea Surface Height Anomaly (SSHA).• Observation Range: Surface to depths ranging from 3 metres to 2,000 metres, depending on the requirement.• Improvement: Enhanced ocean current analysis due to the inclusion of additional information. |
| <p>CubeSat Radio Interferometry Experiment (CURIE)</p> | <p>Why in the news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• NASA is preparing to launch the CubeSat Radio Interferometry Experiment (CURIE) mission, which aims to explore and understand solar radio waves. <p>About CURIE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Objective: Investigate the origins of radio waves from the Sun.• Technique: Uses low-frequency radio interferometry, a first in space.• Function: Detects minute differences in radio wave arrival times to pinpoint their solar origin.• Frequency Range: Measures radio waves in the 0.1 to 19 megahertz range, which are blocked by Earth's upper atmosphere.• Significance:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Advances understanding of solar phenomena.○ Paves the way for future space-based radio astronomy.• Sponsorship: Sponsored by NASA's Heliophysics Flight Opportunities for Research and Technology (H-FORT) Program. |

| <p>Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve</p> | <p>Why in the news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Madhya Pradesh government has launched an investigation into suspected tiger poaching and irregularities at the newly established Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve. <p>About Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Location: Sagar, Damoh, and Narsinghpur districts, Madhya Pradesh.• Includes: Nauradehi Wildlife Sanctuary and Durgavati Wildlife Sanctuary.• Tiger Reserve: Seventh in Madhya Pradesh, named for Rani Durgavati, the queen of the Gond people.• Rivers: Parts of the Narmada and Yamuna River basins.• Fort: Singorgarh Fort located within the reserve.• Vegetation: Dry deciduous type.• Flora: Teak, Saja, Dhaora, Ber, Amla, etc.• Fauna:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Large mammals: Tiger, leopard, wolf, jackal, Indian fox, striped hyena, Nilgai, Chinkara, Chital, Sambhar, Black Buck, Barking deer, Rhesus Macaque.○ Birds: White-Rumped and Indian Vultures (critically endangered).• Development: A green corridor linking Panna Tiger Reserve (PTR) with Durgavati for the natural movement of tigers. |
| <p>Financial Inclusion Index (FI-Index)</p> | <p>Why in the news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Reserve Bank's FI-Index, capturing the extent of financial inclusion across the country, rose to 64.2 in March 2024, showing growth across all parameters. <p>About FI-Index:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• FI-Index Value:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Rose to 64.2 in March 2024.○ Increased from 60.1 in March 2023.• Growth Factors:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Growth observed across all sub-indices.○ Improvement mainly due to the usage dimension, indicating deepening financial inclusion. |
