General Reserve Engineering Force personnel working round-the-clock had partially cleared the highway, but fresh landslides again block traffic bound for Gangtok and Kalimpong. The Sikkim Government has been trying to maintain the flow of essential supplies by transhipment at Likhuvir. Local villagers said that the landslides were much worse than last September when the highway had been reopened after a week by Border Roads organisational personnel. The Teesta was rising alarmingly this morning posing a further threat to the railway lines at Mongpo. A hundred truck loads of boulders are being dumped into the river to check erosion. All major rivers of North Bengal- Leesh, Kaljani, Rydak- as well as the Mahananda were rising. Charland on both banks of the Mahananda have been inundated.
