- 8. Eligible candidates will be called for document verification & personal interview and the call letter will be sent by email only by the Principal of respective Venue JNVs.
- 9. Candidates shall bring printed and self-attested copy of the application form at the time of document verification at the venue.
- **10. Candidates shall bring self-attested 01 set of photocopies** of all required documents and mark list of each Semester/Year of Degree/Post-Graduation/Diploma/Experience certificates/Awards/NCC cert. etc. with originals at the time of document verification at the venue.

 (ii) In case of such Universities which provide for only two subjects out of the six as mentioned above in the final year of graduation, the candidate should have studied Maths and Physics in the final year of examination and three subjects, viz, Maths, Physics and Chemistry / Electronics / Computer Science / Statistics in the first and second years of graduation. (iii) Candidates who have passed B.Sc. degree with Honours in Maths subject would be considered eligible only if they have studied Physics and Chemistry / Electronics / Computer Science / Statistics in first and second year of the course.
