ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

A candidate who has passed B.A., B.Sc., B.Com or any other Bachelor Degree or any Oriental Title (Like Siromani, Vidvan or Pulavar) or B.Litt(Tamil) or any Professional Degree B.E., M.B.B.S examination of this University or an Examination of some other University accepted by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto.

DURATION OF THE COURSE

The course shall extend over a period of TWO academic years consisting of FOUR semesters.

ATTENDANCE

A Candidates will be permitted in appear for the University examinations only if he/she secures not less than 75% of attendance in each subject during the semester.

COURSE OF STUDY

The total number of papers shall 28 including soft skill, internship. The candidates shall take 16 core papers, 7 electives and 4 soft skill papers (including internship) compulsorily during the course. Students should undergo internship during Third semester.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS

The examination for the core and elective shall be divided in to two sessional test and one End-Semester Examination. Sessional tests consist 20 marks each and End –Semester Examination consists of 60 mars (Total 100 marks for each paper).

PASSING MINIMUM

A candidate shall be declared to have passed in each paper he/she secures not less than 50% of the marks prescribed for the examination.
