NOTIFICATION GRIEVANCES FILING PROCESS

The Consortium of National Law Universities has constituted a Grievance Redressal Committee under the Chairmanship of Justice Sri G Raghuram, Former Judge, Andhra Pradesh High Court and Former Director, National Judicial Academy, to receive and resolve any grievances that candidates may have with respect to the Common Law Admission Test 2025 (CLAT 2025).

1. Candidates may file a grievance with respect to the Common Law Admission Test 2025 (CLAT 2025).
2. The portal to file grievances will open at **12 noon on December 08, 2024**.
3. Grievances received over email, support tickets on the website or phone calls will not be considered.
4. Process of filing grievances before the Grievance Redressal Committee:
 - a. Login to your CLAT account;
 - b. Click the 'Submit Grievance' button;
 - c. State the nature of your grievance;
 - d. Describe your grievance (max. 1,000 characters);
 - e. Upload supporting documents;
 - f. Submit the declaration form;
 - g. Click the Submit button.
