7. Answers to the questions are to be written in the space provided for the same after each question.

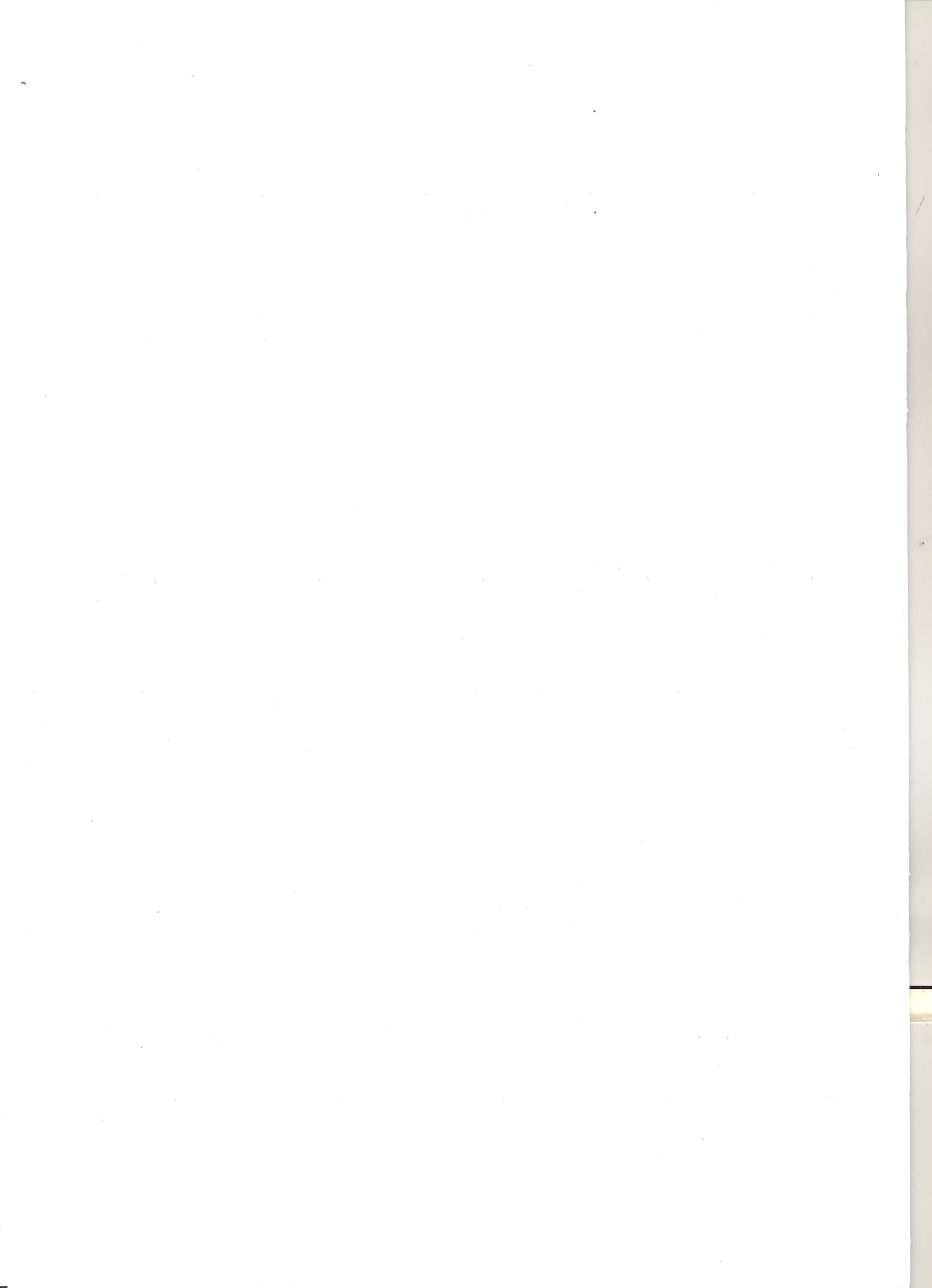
