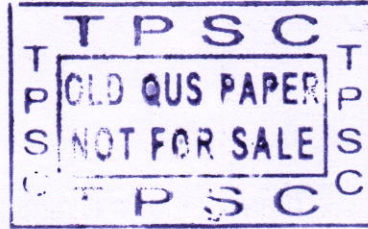

  - (c) If a question is left blank i.e. no answer is given by the candidate, there will be **no penalty** for that question.

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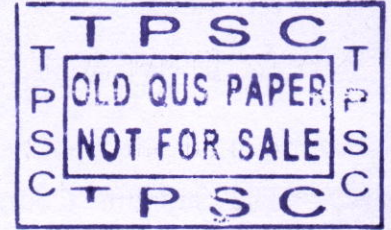
