- 5) Assigning marks against the work experience.
 - i) The candidates who have submitted copies of documents in support of their claim for work experience will be considered for awarding marks. If any candidate has not submitted any document, then mere indication in the form will not be taken into consideration. If the candidate has not completed three years in an organization, the experience will not be taken into consideration.
 - ii) The work experience which has direct bearing on the working of the Pollution Control Board will be given a weightage of 1.
