- The UPSC IES ISS Exam consists of two papers: Indian Economic Service Examination and Indian Statistical Service Examination.
- The question papers for both exams will be of conventional (essay) type except for Statistics Paper I and II, which will be objective type papers.
- The General English and General Studies papers are common to both exams and will be of subjective type.
- The question paper will be set in English only.

### **UPSC Indian Economic Service Exam Pattern**

The UPSC Indian Economic Service (IES) examination is a highly competitive and prestigious exam conducted by the Union Public Service Commission. The exam consists of six papers, including four papers on economics and two papers on general studies. All the papers, except for two objective-type papers on statistics, are of conventional essay type. The examination is conducted in English only. The IES exam pattern is designed to evaluate the candidate's knowledge, understanding, and analytical skills in the field of economics and general studies.

### **UPSC Indian Statistical Service Exam Pattern**

The UPSC Indian Statistical Service (ISS) examination is conducted in two stages: the written examination and the interview. The written examination consists of six papers, including two papers on statistics and four papers on general studies. The statistics papers are

objective type, while the general studies papers are subjective in nature. Candidates who qualify in the written examination will be called for an interview, which carries a weightage of 100 marks. The final selection of candidates is based on their performance in both the written examination and the interview.
