

## TPSC Prelims Exam Syllabus 2023

The TPSC Preliminary Exam Syllabus for 2023 covers a range of subjects, including General Knowledge, Current Affairs, English Language, Mathematics, and Logical Reasoning. Under General Knowledge, candidates are expected to have knowledge of the history, geography, and cultural heritage of India, as well as the Indian Constitution and political system.

TPSC Prelims Section	Tripura PSC Prelims Syllabus
Indian Polity and Economy	Questions on the political system of India, India's constitution, Economy, Panchayati Raj, a system of government, etc will be asked
Mental Ability	Questions on logical reasoning would be asked
History of modern India, the revolt of 1857 and Indian independence (1947)	Questions based on Political, Social, and economic aspects of history, the rise of nationalism, nation-building, and the subsequent independence.
General science and environment	Questions based on basic science, environmental studies, environmental awareness, problems, and solutions.
English Composition	Questions on prepositions, editing/omission, jumbled words, Sentence organization, do as directed, fill-ups, use of phrases and idioms etc.
Geography of India	Questions on Indian Agriculture, Availability of natural resources, geographical conditions of the nation, etc.
Numerical Ability	The syllabus is similar to the compulsory mathematics paper at the Madhyamik Examination of the Tripura Board of Secondary Education <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For history, questions will be based on the period between 1857 and 1947 and the creation of Tripura.</li><li>• For geography, type of soil, forest, natural resources, climatic conditions, etc would be asked and questions on different tribes found, festivals and languages will be asked in the culture of Tripura</li></ul>

## **TPSC Preliminary Exam Pattern**

The TPSC Preliminary Exam consists of a multiple-choice question (MCQ) format and carries a total of 200 marks. The exam is divided into two papers: Paper 1 and Paper 2. Each paper is for 2.5 hours and has 100 questions carrying one mark each.

The TPSC Mains Exam is a written exam that consists of eight papers, including Essay and Precis Writing in English, English Composition, Indian Constitution and Politics, Five-Year Plan, Bengali Composition and Translation, General Knowledge and Current Affairs, and three optional papers.
