(viii) A girl of 15 years was subjugated to give her consent for having sexual intercourse with a man. Does it amount giving consent by the girl?

(ix) Are the records, maintained by the Ward Office of the Municipality, public document?

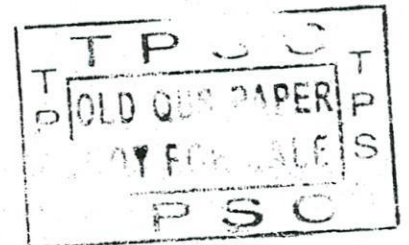

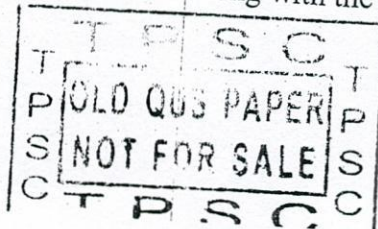
1. Legislative control over the finance is exercised in two stages in a parliamentary set up.

10. Assets created out of grants-in-aid should not be disposal of or utilised without prior sanction of the Government.
