

One Liner Shots (Rise of Magadha)



- ★ The 4 Mahajanapadas Magadha, Kosala, Avanti and Vatsa were contesting for supremacy from the 6th century BCE to the 4th century BCE.
- ★ Finally, Magadha appeared victorious and was competent to acquire sovereignty.
- ★ It became the most powerful kingdom in ancient India.
- ★ Magadha is located in modern Bihar in India.
- ★ Jarasandha, a descendant of Brihadratha, was said to have founded the empire in Magadha. Both are mentioned in the Mahabharata.

Haryanka Dynasty

Founder: The probable founder was Bimbisara's grandfather (566 BC).

Bimbisara (544-492 BC)

- → The real founder of the Haryanka dynasty.
- → He was a contemporary of Buddha and Mahavira.
- → His capital was at **Rajgriha** (Grirvraja)
- → **Jivaka** was his royal physician.
- → 3 major matrimonial alliances of Bimbisara were

- 1. Kosala princess, Mahakoshala
- 2. Lichchhavi Princess, Chellana (Ajatasatru's mother)
- 3. Daughter of Madra (clan) Chief

Ajatasatru (492-460 BC)

- → Son of Bimbisara, who is believed to have assassinated his father for the throne.
- → Most aggressive and powerful ruler.
- → Unlike Bimbisara, he followed military conquest for expansion.
- → Annexed Kosala.
- → Used Mahashilakantaka and Rathamusala.
- → Patronized the 1st Buddist Council.

Udaybhadra or Udayin (460-444 BC)

- → Son of Ajatasatru.
- → Founder of Pataliputra.
- → He shifted the capital from Rajgriha to Pataliputra (modern Patna).
- → He was the last of the major Haryanka rulers.
- → He was murdered at Palaka's (king of Avanti) instigation.
- → He was succeeded by 3 rulers Aniruddha, Munda and Nagadasaka

Sisunaga Dynasty

Sisunag

- → He was an Amatya at Varanasi earlier.
- → Shifted capital to Vaishali temporarily.
- → He defeated Avanti and made it a part of Magadha.

Kalashoka

- → He was the son and successor of Sisunaga.
- → Also known as **Kakavarna**, according to Puranas.
- → Patronized the **2nd Buddhist Council** at Vaishali.

Nanda Dynasty

This was the first **low-caste or non-Kshatriya dynasty**. It lasted from 345 BCE to 321 BCE. The first ruler was Mahapadma Nanda.

Mahapadmananda

- → He was known as 'Ugrasena'.
- → As per Brahmical text, he bolenged to low caste.
- → First empire builder of (North) India.
- → His titles were: **Ekrat** and **Sarva-kshatrantaka**.
- → Acquired Kosala and merged Kalinga with Magadha.

Dhanananda

- → Dhanananda was the last significant Nanda ruler.
- → He was known **as Agrammes or Xandrames** in Greek texts.
- → He had a huge army consisting of infantry, cavalry, elephants and chariots.
- → He had the credit to invent a measure named *Nandopakramani*.
- → He was an arrogant and the most oppressive ruler of the Nanda dynasty.
- → The imposition of heavy taxes on people made him unpopular among the masses.
- → Chandragupta Maurya finally overthrew him with the help of Chanakya.
