  - This theme highlights the connection between environmental protection and sustainable development.

## 11-day India International Grand Trade Fair

#### Context:

An 11-day trade fair started on December 1 at City Square Ground, New Town.

## **Key Points:**

- **Bangladesh** is the partner country for this event.
- Objective: Provide a platform for industries, trade agencies, and MSMEs to showcase products to buyers in an attractive setting.
- Over 10 countries, including Bangladesh, Egypt, UAE, Turkey, Iran, Thailand, Lebanon, Afghanistan, Tunisia, and Malaysia. Also, more than 20 Indian states are participating.

#### Kolkata

- Kolkata, often referred to as the "City of Palaces," is a prominent metropolis situated along the eastern bank of the Hooghly River, serving as the capital of West Bengal. India.
- Formerly known as Calcutta, was declared the capital of British India during the 18th century under the leadership of **Governor-General Warren Hastings.**
- The buildings erected during this period drew inspiration from a variety of architectural styles, including Roman, Gothic and even Mughal influences.

- The Marble Palace
- St. Paul's Cathedral: A Gothic Masterpiece

Digha Beach	<ul> <li>Digha is a popular seaside resort town in West Bengal, India. It's located at the northern end of the Bay of Bengal, about 187 km southwest of Kolkata.</li> <li>Digha is known as the "Brighton of the East"</li> <li>Digha has a 7 km long, shallow sand beach with gentle waves.</li> </ul>
Rice Production in WB	<ul> <li>According to CEIC, West Bengal's rice production in 2023 was 1,471,000 tons.</li> <li>This is a decrease from the previous year's production of 2,401,000 tons.</li> <li>West Bengal is India's largest rice-producing state.</li> <li>In 2020-2021, West Bengal produced 16.6 million tons of rice, which was more than 13% of the country's total grain production.</li> <li>The agriculture ministry estimates that the area for rice production in the 2023 kharif season is 41.1 million hectares.</li> <li>This is higher than the 40.42 million hectares during the same season in 2022.</li> <li>However, erratic rains and a dry August have impacted the paddy crop.</li> <li>The USDA projects that India's rice production for 2023-2024 will be 132 million metric tonnes, which is almost a 3% dip from 2022-2023.</li> </ul>
