18th Dooars Utsav	 The 18th Dooars Utsav is scheduled to commence soon in the state. The 11-day-long festival has been organized at the Parade Ground, Alipurduar. It showcases the rich and diverse culture of the region, comprising tea gardens and dense forests
State's first orchid festival	 The Minister of Food Processing Industry and Horticulture has inaugurated the state's first orchid festival at Mohit Nagar in Jalpaiguri. This was done to promote orchid cultivation in the state. Orchid cultivation has now started in various districts of the state, including Howrah and Medinipur due to increased demand.
Dokra craft	 In 2018, the Dokra craft from West Bengal was presented with the Geographical Indication (GI) tag. Dokra is a form of ancient bell metal craft practiced by the Ojha metalsmiths living in states like Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, West Bengal and Telangana. However, the style and also the workmanship of this artisan community varies in different states. Dhokra or Dokra, is also known as bell metal craft. The name 'Dhokra' comes from the Dhokra Damar tribes, who are the traditional metal smiths of West Bengal. Their technique of lost wax casting is named after their tribe, hence Dhokra metal casting
