New Chief Secretary Appointment	 The West Bengal government appointed Bhagwati Prasad Gopalika, a 1989-batch IAS officer and the current Home Secretary, as the new Chief Secretary. IAS officer Nandini Chakraborty was appointed as the Home Secretary of the West Bengal government. Ms. Chakraborty is the second female officer to hold the State's Home Secretary position after Lina Chakraborty.

This is being done on the directions of the NGT to the civic body which comes in the wake of a petition that was filed in the tribunal regarding high arsenic contents in the groundwater in Kolkata and South 24-Parganas. The KMC is also focusing on rainwater harvesting following the directions from the state environment impact assessment authority.
Govt-run free primary school introduces students safety system	 The teachers of Raiganj Girls' Free Primary School of North Dinajpur district introduced the Students Safety Management Arrival Departure system. A biometric-like machine has been set up in the school. Now, when a student arrives at school will touch the machine with the digital identity card., Immediately the guardian will receive a message in their smartphone that the child has reached the school safely.
