Habra: CM unveils projects worth more than Rs 8K crore	 In a virtual ceremony held at Habra, North 24 Parganas, WB CM inaugurated and laid the foundation stones for 647 projects valued at over Rs 8,405 crore across the state. This included the launch of the Karmashree project, guaranteeing 50 days of work and wages to registered workers. Some key projects announced include: Habra-Gaighata water project (worth Rs 851 crore) Completion of Kalyani Expressway extension (from Muragacha to Kapa) at Rs 530 crore Three new transmission substations in Rajarhat, Minakhan, and Barrackpore for Rs 351.43 crore
KMC offers another 1% rebate for online property tax payment	 The Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) is offering an extra 1% rebate on property taxes paid online This incentive aims to encourage residents to switch to online payments for their property tax bills. About: Previously, a 5% rebate was available for payments made by the due date. With this new policy, taxpayers can now enjoy a total rebate of up to 6%. There's a caveat, though - the additional 1% rebate is capped at Rs 200 and only applies to those who opt to receive their bills electronically.
State launches death benefit scheme for weavers & artisans	 The WB government has launched a new scheme to provide financial assistance to the families of weavers and artisans who die before the age of 60. In case of such an untimely demise, the scheme offers a one-time benefit of Rs 2 lakh to the next of kin. This initiative aims to provide much-needed financial relief to families who depend on the income of weavers and artisans.
