Contempt of court issued against Chief Secy, Home Secy & ADG CID	 Context: Calcutta High Court issued a contempt of court order against the state's Chief Secretary, Home Secretary and Additional Director General (ADG) Criminal Investigation Department (CID) over non-compliance of order regarding handing over of documents to NIA in the Darivit firing case.
	 About: Contempt of court is essentially disrespect or disobedience towards a court of law. It can be behavior that disrupts court proceedings, interferes with getting evidence, or disobeys a court order.
	 There are two main types: Civil contempt: This involves disobeying a court order, like failing to pay child support. Criminal contempt: This involves actions that undermine the court's authority or interfere with a fair trial, like threatening a witness or juror. Articles 129 and 215 empower the Supreme Court and High Courts respectively to punish contempt of themselves.
State Higher Edu Council replaces three subjects	 Context: The West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) has replaced three elective subjects with a focus on contemporary relevance. Subjects with low enrollment like Gujarati, French, and Punjabi have been dropped. 	 About: The March equinox or northward equinox is the equinox on the Earth when the subsolar point appears to leave the Southern Hemisphere and cross the celestial equator, heading northward as seen from Earth. The March equinox is known as the vernal equinox (spring equinox) in the Northern Hemisphere and as the autumnal equinox (autumn equinox) or fall equinox in the Southern Hemisphere.
