6 Bengal seats get 'financially sensitive' tag

Context:

- In a historic move, the Election Commission (EC)
 has identified six Bengal Lok Sabha seats as

- These seats are Darjeeling, Asansol, Malda South, Bongaon, Kolkata North, and Kolkata South.

Key points:

- A huge amount of money was seized from these constituencies during previous elections.
- A large quantity of liquor was also confiscated from here.
- Going by these records, these constituencies have been declared financially sensitive

Bengal Governor Clears 3 Pending Bills, Providing Fiscal Relief



Context:

 Bengal Governor C V Ananda Bose approved three crucial bills on Tuesday, easing the state's fiscal situation.

Key points:

- The Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (Amendment) Bill 2024 was cleared, allowing the state government to increase the maximum fiscal deficit from 3% to 3.5% of the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP).
 - The Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (FRBM) Amendment Act allows for additional annual borrowing space of 0.5% of GSDP for 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25, as recommended by the 15th Finance Commission to enhance the operational and economic efficiency of the power sector.
 - These approvals will facilitate the smooth operation of various social security schemes like Lakshmir Bhandar and Karma Sathi, which previously faced financial constraints due to exceeding the allocated budget.
