• The female electorate in West Bengal has shown significant growth over the past five years, with three constituencies—Dum Dum, Jadavpur, and Hooghly—having more female voters than male voters, according to the latest data from the Election Commission (EC).

y points:

- This marks a notable increase from 2019 when only Dum Dum had more female electors than males.
- Additionally, in ten other parliamentary constituencies, the margin between male and female voters is less than 20.000, indicating the considerable influence of female voters in around one-third of the state's 42 constituencies.
- The total number of electors in West Bengal has risen from 70,001,284 in the 2019 Lok Sabha elections to 75,925,571 in 2024, representing an 8.4% growth rate.
- The growth rate of female voters has been higher at 9.6%, increasing from 34,048,666 to 37,351,345.
- In contrast, the number of male electors has increased from 35,951,289 to 38,572,457, indicating a growth rate of 7.2%.
- The gender ratio in West Bengal has shown remarkable improvement, increasing from 949 in 2019 to 968 in 2024, compared to the national increase from 928 to 948.
- Twelve states and Union Territories, including Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, and Kerala, now have more women voters than men.

Kolkata Port breaks all-time record by handling 66.4 MMT cargo

Context:

The Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port (SMP) in Kolkata set a new record by handling 66.4 Million Metric Tonnes (MMT) of cargo, surpassing the previous record of 65.66 MMT moved in 2022-23. This marks a 1.11% increase.
