4) ANS a) Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying

Sagar Parikrama is a program aimed at reaching out to the fishing community in all coastal areas of the country. This initiative has been initiated to understand the problems, experiences and needs of the fishermen and to create awareness among the fishermen in the coastal areas about the various schemes of the government. 9th Phase of Sagar Parikrama will be participated by Tamil Nadu and Puducherry Fisheries Department Officers, District Officers, Central Government Fisheries Department, National Fisheries Development Board, Indian Coast Guard, Indian Fisheries Research Centre, National Fisheries Post-harvest Technical and Training Institute, Central Fisheries Maritime and Engineering Training Senior officials. Tamil Nadu has a coastline of 1,076 km. It is the second largest coastal state in the country. The state is rich in marine, brackish and inland fisheries and suitable for fishing and culture. The first eight phase of the Sagar Parikrama covered 4,115 km across 8 coastal states and union territories including Gujarat, Diu and Daman, Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, Puducherry and Andaman and Nicobar.

5) ANS b) Arunachal Pradesh

Yak Surbi of Arunachal Pradesh, a natural milk product made from yaks milk, has been awarded the prestigious Geographical Indication (GI) status. The yak is a mammal found in the Himalayan region.

6) ANS b) Tirunelveli

The Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project is a nuclear power plant complex located in Kudankulam, Tirunelveli district, Tamil Nadu. It is the largest nuclear power plant in India and one of the largest in Asia. The plant is being built in phases, with four units currently operational and six more under construction.

The Kudankulam Nuclear Power Plant is being built in collaboration with Russia.

Vithya Ramaraj equaled P.T Usha's 39-year-old record in the 400m hurdles race. P.T Usha participated 23rd Olympics in 1984 at the Los Angeles and finished

It is a glacial-moraine-dammed lake, located at 5200 mt above sea level in Sikkim's far northwestern region. It is one of the 14 potentially dangerous lakes susceptible to Glacial lake outburst flood (GLOFs). It formed due to the melting of the Lhonak glacier. The sudden overflow of South Lhonak lake caused flash floods in the Teesta river. At least 14 people died and 102 went missing after the cloudburst in the tiny hilly state.
