1) ANS d) Nargis Mohammadi

The Nobel Peace Prize for 2023 has been awarded to Nargis Mohammadi. She is the 19th woman to receive the Nobel Peace Prize. Narges Mohammadi is awarded for her fight against the oppression of women in Iran and her fight to promote human rights and freedom for all . The first woman won Nobel peace Prize Berta von Satner of Hungary. She was awarded the Nobel Prize for Peace in 1905. Mother Teresa was the sixth woman. She was awarded the Nobel Prize in 1979.

2) ANS b) October 6

World Cerebral Palsy Day is observed on October 6. Cerebral Palsy is a lifelong disability with no known cure. The day celebrates lives of 17 million people living with Cerebral Palsy, bringing people living with cerebral palsy, their families, allies, supporters and organisations across more than 100 countries together. The theme for World Cerebral Palsy Day in 2023 is "Together Stronger."

3) ANS b) Telangana

The Telangana Government has launched the 'Prime Minister's Breakfast Scheme' for Government School Students on 6th October. This will provide nutritious meals to the students and reduce the burden of working mothers. This scheme is being offered to 23 lakh students of Government schools from Class 1 to 10. Tamil Nadu was the first state launched the Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme on 15th September, 2022. Breakfast is provided on all school working days to all primary school children studying in government schools from class 1 to class 5.













4) ANS b) Madhya Pradesh

Madhya Pradesh government has announced a policy to promote gender equality and women's empowerment by reserving 35% of all state government job positions for women, excluding the Forest Department. 50% of teaching positions will be reserved for women emphasizing the government's commitment to gender balance and women's empowerment in the education sector.

5) ANS b) Gwalior

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the country's first high-tech sports training centre for Divyangjan, named after former Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh. This initiative aims to provide equal opportunities in sports, enhance talent, and encourage participation in various sports disciplines.

6)ANS b)Jyoti Sureka

Jyoti Surekha won gold medals in all the sports she participated in at the 19th Asian Games. An archer, she won gold medals in all three categories of individual, mixed doubles and women's team at the 19th Asian Games. Through this she has participated in the Asian Games and has won gold in all of them

7)ANS c) 3

India had already served two terms as President, Asia- Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD) from 2018 – 2021 and 2021 – 2023 India has been elected as President of AIBD GC for the 3rd successive term to lead the prestigious international organisation.AIBD, established in 1977 under the auspices of UNESCO is a unique regional inter-governmental organisation.Holding such prestigious post at an international broadcasting Institute not only reflects strong trust of the international media in India & Prasar Bharati but also lays the foundation for India to achieve strategically further milestones in the field of broadcasting.













8)ANS d)October 8

World Dyslexia Day is observed on October 8th each year. Dyslexia is a common learning disorder that affects a person's ability to read and write properly. Skills taken granted for such as reading and writing fluently, is an area of challenge for those who have dyslexia. World Dyslexia Day raises awareness about these issues and what can be done to manage such a disorder. The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities under Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. the Department conducting various events across the country to spread awarness of dyslexia.

9)ANS c) 6.5%

The current rate of repo rate, known as the interest rate on short-term loans to banks, is 6.5%. Reserve Bank of India Governor Shaktikanta Das announced the bimonthly monetary policy for the fiscal year 2023-24. The bank kept the position steady and announced the reportate at 6.5%. This is the fourth time that RBI has kept the repo rate unchanged.

10) ANS b) Coimbatore

Coimbatore Corporation floats tender for Rs 72 lakh STEM park. The Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) has floated a tender to set up a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) park. The first STEM Park in India was established in the city of Thanjavur, Tamil Nadu.
