### 1) ANS b) Israel

Operation Iron Swords was Israel's response to a surprise attack on Israel by the Palestinian Islamist militant group Hamas. On October 7, Hamas launched its largest offensive against Israel, killing at least 100 people and claiming it had taken dozen of hostages. Operation Iron Swords is a retaliated action against an organization that infiltrated Israel and carried out attacks on civilians and Israeli security forces. Operation Al –Aqsa Storm is a military operation and surpise attack by hamas group on israel in 7<sup>th</sup> october 2023.

## 2) ANS b) Bihar

First state to take caste based census is Bihar. Government of Bihar started caste based survey on January 2023 and released the results recently. They are 36.01% Extremely Backward Class, 27.13% Other Backward Class, 19.65% Scheduled Caste, 14% Yadavs, and 3% Musahars.

## 3) ANS a)Claudia Goldin

The 2023 Nobel Economics prize was awarded to Claudia Goldin(USA) "for having advanced our understanding of women's labour market outcomes". Richard Thaler is the winner of the 2017 Nobel Prize in Economics and Angus Deaton is the winner of the 2015 Nobel Prize in Economics and Jean Troll is the winner of the 2014 Nobel Prize in Economics. The first Nobel Prize in Economics has been awarded since 1969.

The World Heritage Site Sanchi in Madhya Pradesh's Raisen district has become India's first solar city. Sanchi, which will reduce annual carbon dioxide emissions by 13,747 tonnes. This is equivalent to more than 2,38,000 trees. Government of Uttra Pradesh also announced Ayothi will become first solar city in Uttrapradesh.

### 5) ANS a) 1

The Indian men's doubles badminton pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty created history by winning India's first gold medal in badminton at the Asian Games. In the final, they won the gold medal by defeating the Korean pair by 21-18, 21-16. This is the first gold medal won in badminton at the Asian Games.

### 6) ANS d) October 9

World Post Day is celebrated each year on October 9th to commemorate the creation of the Universal Postal Union (UPU) in 1874. In 2023, the theme is "Together for Trust: Collaborating for a safe and connected future."

16th Agricultural Science Congress to be held in Kochi. The primary aim of the Agricultural Science Congress is to generate a scientific discourse around transforming India's agri-food systems into sustainable enterprises to facilitate its benefit for generations to come. Organised by the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences (NAAS), the Agricultural Science Congress is being held for the first time in Kerala. The Congress will discuss 10 thematic areas, including all issues related to agriculture and allied areas and sustainability issues on land and water, agricultural production systems, products, agricultural machinery, climate action, economics, renewable or alternative energy, precision farming, alternative farming systems, coastal agriculture, next-generation technologies, etc.

### 8)ANS d) 54.

In the special report published by the Registrar General of India regarding the period of child mortality for the year 2018-2020, Tamil Nadu has decreased by 54 compared to the previous survey. Maternal mortality is a key performance indicator for efforts to improve the health and safety of mothers before and after childbirth in countries around the world. Maternal mortality rate (MMR) is defined as the number of maternal deaths per 100,000 live births regardless of gestational age or due to termination of pregnancy. Commonly referred to as MMR. And in 2022-2023 it has decreased to 52 per one lakh in Tamil Nadu. Maternal Mortality for India is 97 for the year 2018-20.

### 9)ANS a) National Sample Survey Office

National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) launched Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) in April 2017. The objective of PLFS is to estimate the key employment and unemployment indicators (viz. Worker Population Ratio, Labour Force Participation Rate, Unemployment Rate) in the short time interval of three months in both rural and urban areas annually.

## 10) ANS **d) 25 January**

National Voters' Day (NVD) is celebrated on 25th January by the Election Commission of India (ECI) .National Voter's helps in awareness generation about the voting rights of Indian Citizens. Election commission announced the dates of legislative assembly election dates for Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, and Mizoram.
