Operation Bluestar was an Indian Army operation in 1984. This operation was carried out on the order of Indira Gandhi who was the Prime Minister of India at the time in order to catch the Sikh separatists who entered the Golden Temple in Amritsar. This military operation caused great agitation among Sikhs all over the world. Many Sikhs who were in Indian civil service and army resigned. Some Sikhs also returned the awards and certificates of appreciation given by the Government of India .Four months after the military operation Indira Gandhi was assassinated by two Sikh bodyguards on 31 December 1984. Government of India and leaders observed indira gandhi's 39th death anniversary.

Deep Narayan Nayak, a teacher from West Bengal, has achieved recognition as one of the top 10 finalists for the Global Teacher Prize 2023.
