Prime Minister of India going to launch the PM-PVTG Development Mission scheme aimed at fostering the comprehensive development of approximately 28 lakh people belonging to Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs). This scheme was launched on the birth anniversary celebration of the tribal freedom fighter, Birsa Munda on November 15.

PM-PVTG Development Mission aims to address the critical needs of the 75 PVTG communities residing in over 22,000 remote villages across 18 States and Union Territories. The focus areas include power, water, road connectivity, housing, education, and healthcare. This comprehensive approach aligns with the government's commitment to uplifting marginalized communities.

2) ANS a) Ministry of Agriculture

Ministry of Agriculture launched 'PM Kisan Bhai' scheme designed to empower farmers by breaking the monopoly of traders in determining crop prices. Aims to supporting small and marginal farmers who face challenges in storing their produce while waiting for optimal market conditions. Also it aims to provide farmers with the autonomy to decide when to sell, allowing them to retain their crops for a minimum of three months post-harvest.

The 6th High-Level Meeting of the India-OPEC Energy Dialogue took place at the OPEC Secretariat in Vienna, Austria. This meeting focuses on ensuring availability, affordability, and sustainability to guarantee the stability of energy markets globally also it is discuss about crucial issues related to oil and energy markets.

Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare has launched Nationwide Digital Life Certificate Campaign 2.0 from 1st – 30th November, 2023. Nationwide Digital Life Certificate Campaign 2.0 is being organized at 500 locations in 100 cities in all States and Union territories of India. the identity of a person is established through face authentication technique and DLC gets generated. In 2014, submission of DLCs using biometric devices was commenced. Subsequently, the Department engaged with MeitY and UIDAI to develop a Face Authentication technology system based on Aadhar database, whereby it is possible to submit LC from any Android based smart phone. As per this facility, the identity of a person is established through face authentication technique and DLC gets generated. This breakthrough technology, launched in November 2021, reduced the dependence of pensioners on external bio-metric devices and made the process more accessible and affordable to masses by leveraging Smartphone-based technology.

5) ANS c) November 7

National Cancer Awareness Day is an annual observance in India, held on November 7th, aimed at raising public awareness about the importance of early cancer detection, prevention strategies. This significant day was first initiated in 2014. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), cancer is the second leading cause of death worldwide, accounting for nearly 1 in 6 deaths globally.
