1) ANS a)Dubai

28th United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP 28) held in Dubai. It is held from 30 November until 12 December 2023. The conference has been held annually since the first UN climate agreement in 1992. The COP conferences are intended for governments to agree on policies to limit global temperature rises and adapt to impacts associated with climate change.

The Union government has selected three projects being implemented in TN for discussion at the United Nations Conference of Parties (COP28) to be held in Dubai from November 30 to December 12. Total seven projects have been hand-picked by the Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the global event. The three TamilNadu projects include:

- 1. Meendum Manjappai campaign
- 2. Tamil Nadu Green Climate Company (TNGCC)
- 3. Women Eco-Warrior project

2) ANS a) New Delhi

2023 Khelo India - Para Games held in New Delhi. The Khelo India Para Games for the differently abled will be held from December 10 to 17. More than 1,350 athletes from a total of 32 states and union territories are expected to participate in these games. Ujjwala'- a sparrow, was unveiled as the official mascot of Khelo India – Para Games 2023.

3) ANS a) Ladakh

Southeast Asia's first night sky sanctuary to be located in New Delhi. The Sanctuary is being set up with the help of Indian Institute of Astrophysics Bengaluru which is affiliated to the Department of Science & Technology Government of India. The Dark Sky Reserve will be located at Hanle village in Eastern Ladakh as a part of Changthang Wildlife Sanctuary. It will boost Astrotourism in India and will be one of the world's highest-located sites for optical, infra-red, and gamma-ray telescopes.

4) ANS b) Damoh

India's largest tiger reserve will setup in Damoh, Madhyapradesh. Indian government has approved to merge the two wildlife sanctuaries (Nauradehi Wildlife Sanctuary and Durgavati Wildlife Sanctuary) to create the largest tiger reserve in the country in Damoh. It will be 2,300 square kilometres.
