TN coasts to get tourism boost	 In a bid to lure more tourists, the Tamil Nadu government has decided to develop coastal tourism including cruise facilities, short-haul leisure ferri Plan is to increase the tourism potential of Tamil Nadu's 1,000 km coastline. The authorities of the Tourism Department are looking at developing locales such as northernmost Marina Beach, which is the world's second longest urban beach.
Chola-era idol traced to Swiss gallery	 Context: An exquisite 12th century Chola-era Somaskanda idol, smuggled out of India at least two decades ago, has been traced to a private gallery/collector in Switzerland. The patination on the bronze indicated it was most likely part of a buried hoard taken out, after 1994, by idol smuggler Subhash Kapoor and sold to a private collector in Zurich in 2005
700 years ago, Mesolithic inscription found	 Context: Historical researchers have discovered a 700 year old stone inscription near Krishnagiri The inscription conveys the message of Bhagaiva Kanda Marayan, the son of Kuruvenda Marayan, who defeated Jayangkonda Chola Marasu who tried to destroy Kodukuor. Somsu, the leader of the army, was killed in the fight that led him astray The word Tantri in the inscription refers to the leader of the force.
Chembarambakkam Lake	Context: • As the water level coming into Chembarambakkam lake is increasing due to heavy rainfalls, the release of excess water from lake was translated to 2,429 cubic feet.

Lakes of Tamil Nadu:

- In the first-ever national census of waterbodies conducted by Union Jal Shakti Ministry, Tamil Nadu has emerged at the top with 13,629 lakes.
- It is one of the two rain-fed reservoirs from where water is drawn for supply to Chennai City,

	 the other one being the Puzhal Lake. The Adyar River originates from this lake. A part of water supply of the metropolis of Chennai is drawn from this lake. This was the first Artificial lake built by Rajendra Chola I the son of Rajaraja Chola and Thiripuvana Madeviyar, prince of Kodumbalur.
TN govt signs MoUs for Rs 5,567 crore MSME investments	 The MSME department of the Tamil Nadu government signed 293 MoUs to bring in investments of 5,567 crore. The investments will be made across sectors such as auto components manufacturing, aerospace and defence equipment, electronic gadgets, IT equipment and trading in the Chennai region These investments will generate direct employment for 26,477 people.
