The deficit amount has, in fact, increased by 108 crore, compared to the 2023-24 budget, when the deficit was pegged at 10.2 crore. As per the budget, the corporation is expecting revenue receipts to the tune of 1,636.3 crore and capital receipts to the tune of 1,545.9 crore in the fiscal, against a revenue expenditure of 1,353.1 crore and a capital expenditure of 1,947.4 crore.
