<p>Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016</p>	<p>Why in the news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court has taken cognizance of a public interest litigation (PIL) petition, urging authorities to ensure that all government offices in Tamil Nadu are accessible to differently-abled individuals. <p>About Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enactment and Objective: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enacted by the Parliament of India in December 2016. Aimed at ensuring equal opportunities, protection of rights, and full participation of persons with disabilities. Key Provisions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Definition Expansion: The Act expands the definition of disabilities from 7 to 21 conditions, including autism, cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, and multiple disabilities. Reservation in Employment: Increased reservation for persons with disabilities in government jobs from 3% to 4%. Educational Rights: Mandates inclusive education and reservation of seats for children with disabilities in higher educational institutions. Accessibility: Requires both public and private establishments to adhere to accessibility norms and standards. Legal Capacity: Recognizes the legal capacity of persons with disabilities on an equal basis with others in all aspects of life. Special Courts: Establishment of special courts in each district to handle cases concerning the violation of rights of persons with disabilities. Chief Commissioner and State Commissioners: Appointment of a Chief Commissioner for persons with disabilities at the central level and State Commissioners at the state level for redressal of grievances.

<p>Direct purchase Centres (DPC)</p>	<p>Why in the news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Minister for Food and Civil Supplies revealed plans to construct 50 new buildings for direct purchase centres (DPC) in 14 districts, under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme. <p>About DPC:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Definition: Direct Purchase Centres (DPC) are facilities set up by government agencies to directly procure agricultural produce from farmers. • Objective: The main objective of DPCs is to ensure that farmers get fair and remunerative prices for their produce without the involvement of middlemen. • Location: DPCs are typically established in rural areas close to the farming communities to facilitate easy access for farmers. • Products Procured: These centres primarily procure staple crops such as rice, wheat, and other grains, depending on the region and the agricultural produce predominant there. • Government Agencies: Agencies such as the Food Corporation of India (FCI) and state-level agricultural marketing boards manage the DPCs. • Pricing: DPCs purchase produce at Minimum Support Prices (MSP) set by the government to safeguard farmers against price fluctuations.
