Places in news: Western Ghats	 Why in news? Around 337 butterfly species have been identified in the Western Ghats and proposed to be included under Wildlife Protection Act(WLPA) 1972. Out of these, 40 species were found to be endemic and 22 on the IUCN Red- List, of which two are near threatened and the rest are in the least concern category. Key Points: The Western Ghats, also known as the Sahyadri Hills, are well known for their rich and unique assemblage of flora and fauna. The range is called Sahyadri in northern Maharashtra and Sahya Parvatham in Kerala. The northern portion of the narrow coastal plain between the Western Ghats and the Arabian Sea is known as the Konkan Coast. The central portion is called Kanara and the southern portion is called Malabar region or the Malabar Coast. In the south the range is known as the Nilgiri malai in Tamil Nadu. It is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
