




<p><b>India reiterates call for a 'sovereign Palestine state'</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b> India reiterated its call for the <b>creation of a sovereign Palestinian state</b> saying that there was an "obligation" to uphold humanitarian principles.</p> <p><b>India's stand</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• India's position on Palestine has been <b>"long-standing and consistent"</b>.</li> <li>• India always advocated the resumption of direct negotiations towards establishing a sovereign, independent and viable state of Palestine, living within secure and recognised borders, <b>side by side at peace with Israel</b>.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Retail inflation cooled from 6.83% in Aug. to 5% in Sept.</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b> India's retail inflation eased from 6.83% in August to 5.02% in September with the rise in food prices easing to 6.6% from almost 10%.</p> <p><b>About Monetary Policy Committee (MPC):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The <b>Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 (RBI Act)</b> has been amended by the <b>Finance Act, 2016</b> to provide for a statutory and institutionalized framework for a MPC.</li> <li>• The MPC is entrusted with the task of fixing the <b>benchmark policy rate</b> (repo rate) required to contain inflation within the specified target level.</li> <li>• MPC will have <b>six members</b> - the RBI Governor (Chairperson), the RBI Deputy Governor in charge of monetary policy, one official nominated by the RBI Board, and the remaining three members would represent the Government of India.</li> <li>• The MPC takes <b>decisions based on a majority vote</b>. In case of a tie, the RBI governor will have the second or casting vote.</li> <li>• The decision of the MPC would be <b>binding</b> on the RBI.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Inflation cooled to 5% in September</b></p>	<p><b>Key facts</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rajasthan and Haryana recorded the <b>steepest inflation</b> at 6.5%.</li> <li>• Inflation was the lowest in Chhatisgarh at <b>1.98%</b></li> <li>• It was below the <b>5% mark</b> in eight other States, including Tamil Nadu (4.5%), Madhya Pradesh</li> </ul>



	<p>and West Bengal (3.7% each), and Kerala (4.7%).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Costs of services like health, up 5.9% in September, and personal care, up 8.5% , are still rising.</li></ul>
<p><b>Global Hunger Index (GHI) 2023</b></p> 	<p><b>Context</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• India ranks <b>111 out of a total of 125 countries</b> in the Global Hunger Index (GHI) 2023, with its progress against hunger nearly halted since 2015, reflecting a global trend.</li><li>• The Union government, though, contested India's performance for the third year in a row, citing flawed methodology.</li></ul> <p><b>Key points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• India's ranking is based on a GHI score of <b>28.7</b> on a 100-point scale</li><li>• This categorises India's severity of hunger as "serious".</li><li>• The Global Hunger Index (GHI) is a tool for <b>comprehensively measuring and tracking hunger</b> at global, regional, and national levels.</li><li>• GHI scores are based on the values of four component indicators:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Undernourishment</li><li>2. Child stunting</li><li>3. Child wasting</li><li>4. Child mortality</li></ol></li><li>• The GHI score is calculated on a 100-point scale reflecting the severity of hunger - zero is the best score (implies no hunger) and 100 is the worst.</li><li>• The GHI is prepared by European NGOs of <b>Concern Worldwide and Welthungerhilfe.</b></li></ul>
<p><b>Parliamentary Forum on 'LiFE: Lifestyle for Environment'</b></p>  <p>Reduce, Reuse and Recycle' and circular economy have been part of the lifestyle of Indians for thousands of years</p> <p>PM Narendra Modi's Remarks During The Launch Of Mission LiFE</p>	<p><b>Context</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Speaker addressed the Parliamentary Forum on 'LiFE: Lifestyle for Environment', ahead of the ninth G-20 Parliamentary Speakers' Summit (P-20).</li><li>• The pre-P-20 Summit event focused on Mission Lifestyle.</li></ul> <p><b>About LiFE Mission</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mission LiFE, or Lifestyle for Environment, is an India-led global mass movement to nudge individual and community action to protect and preserve the environment.</li><li>• It was launched by the Indian Prime Minister at the 26th UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties (<b>COP26</b>) in Glasgow in November 2021.</li></ul>

<p><b>IIP rises at 14-month high of 10.3%</b></p>	<p><b>Context</b> India’s industrial output surged at a 14-month high pace of 10.3% in August, from a revised 6% rise in July, aided by favourable base effects</p> <p><b>About IIP</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is one of the Prime indicators of economic development for the measurement of trends in the behavior of Industrial Production over a period of time with reference to a chosen base year.</li> <li>• It indicates the relative change of physical production in the field of industries during a specified year as compared to the previous year.</li> <li>• It is computed and published by the Central Statistical Organisation (CSO) on a monthly basis.</li> <li>• The current base year for the IIP series in India is 2011-12.</li> </ul> <p><b>About Eight Core Sectors</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These comprise 40.27% of the weight of items included in the Index of Industrial Production (IIP).</li> <li>• The eight core sector industries in decreasing order of their weightage: Refinery Products&gt; Electricity&gt; Steel&gt; Coal&gt; Crude Oil&gt; Natural Gas&gt; Cement&gt; Fertilizers.</li> </ul>
<p><b>World Arthritis Day</b></p> 	<p><b>Context</b> <b>October 12</b> is marked as World Arthritis Day.</p> <p><b>Key points</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This year 2023, the World Arthritis Day Theme is <b>"Living with an RMD at all stages of life"</b></li> <li>• Arthritis is an inflammatory joint disorder, which affects the joints tissues around the joint, and other connective tissues, causing joint pain and stiffness.</li> <li>• Most common are <b>osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis</b>.</li> </ul>
