Context:

- All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in **Bibinagar**, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district is making preparations to **provide melodious music to the patients** suffering from diseases as well as to **give medical advice and suggestions** on health problems.
- A **radio station is going to be established** here in AIIMS.
- The permission has been received from the **Ministry of Broadcasting** of the Central Government to set up this station which operates **within a radius of 15 km**
- This radio station **operates under 89.6 MHz**.
- Through this melodious music is played for the patients.
- Programs with information about free medical camps, medical services available at AIIMS and other details will also be broadcast.

Suryapet has seen rapid development
after formation of Telangana state

Context:

- Though Suryapet is the only major town on the Hyderabad-Vijayawada national highway, it had lagged behind in terms of development till the formation of the Telangana state in 2014.
- The face of Suryapet has changed after development works began in 2020.

About Suryapet:

- Suryapet is located about **134 kilometers** (83 mi) **east of** the state capital, **Hyderabad**.
- It has a long and rich history dating back to the **6th century AD**.
- The city was **initially known as Suryapuri**
- It was ruled by various dynasties, including the **Pallavas, Chalukyas, and Kakatiyas**.
- Under the **rule of the Kakatiyas, Suryapet flourished** as a commercial and cultural center.
- The **annual Suryapet Jatara is a major Hindu festival** that attracts thousands of pilgrims from across the state.

TS-bPASS



Context:

1. **TS-bPASS, or Telangana State Building Permission Approvals and Services System, is a single-window online platform** for processing various permissions required during **development of land and construction of buildings** in the state of Telangana, India.
2. It is designed to **streamline the process of obtaining building permits** and other approvals, making it more efficient and transparent for citizens and businesses.

Key features of TS-bPASS:

1. **Single-window platform:** TS-bPASS provides a single interface for submitting applications, making payments, and tracking the status of approvals, eliminating the need to interact with multiple departments.
2. **Online submission and tracking:** Applications can be submitted online, and the status of applications can be tracked online, providing real-time updates to applicants.
