Two more mandals carved out of Nirmal	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two more new mandals, Malegaon and Beltharoda, were created in Nirmal district, simplifying administration. • Malegaon, a village in Kubheer mandal was converted into a mandal headquarters. • The new mandal consists of 13 villages such as Sanvli, New Sanvli, Hampoli (B), Mola, Antharni, Pangra, Godsara, Sonari, Nigwa, Malegaon, Godapur, Kupti, Pangarpand, and Bakot. Kubheer comprising 41 gram panchayats was considered as the largest mandal in erstwhile Adilabad district. • Beltharoda, a village in Thanur mandal, became a mandal centre. • It was formed by merging 12 villages namely Beltharoda, Bhosi, Mahalingi, Bamni, Bamnithanda, Bondrat, Jhari (B), Jhari (B) Thanda, Bolsa, Borigaon, Bembar and Umri (K).

Background:

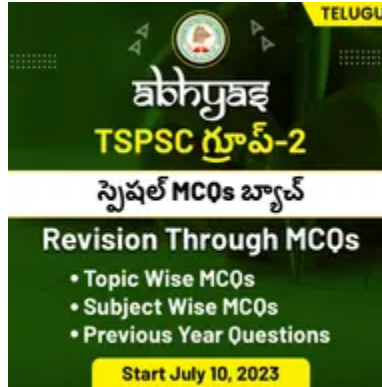
- Following India's independence from British rule in 1947, the princely states, including Hyderabad, were given the choice to accede to either India or Pakistan.

Operation Polo:

- The operation was swift and successful, with the Nizam's forces surrendering within a week.
