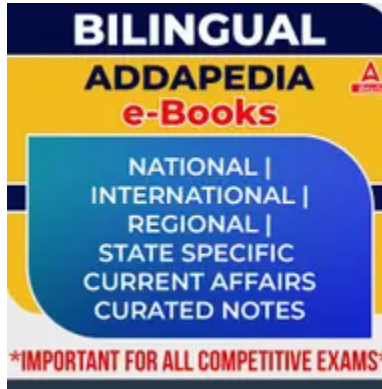
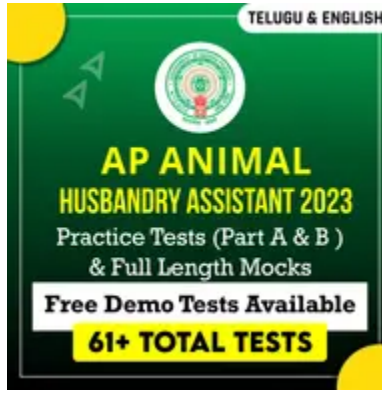


The 39th All India Postal Table Tennis Tournament will be held in Vijayawada
