<p><b>GHMC to revive Prajavani programme</b></p>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The <b>Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC)</b> is taking a step towards improved public engagement with the revival of the Prajavani programme.</li> <li>This initiative aims to provide a direct platform for citizens to address their grievances with civic authorities.</li> </ul> <p><b>About:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Prajavani</b>, meaning "Voice of the People," was launched in 2016 as a weekly direct contact programme.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Hyderabad ranks fifth city for women in India</b></p> 	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Hyderabad</b> has earned the fifth position in the "Top Cities for Women in India 2023" index</li> <li>This recognition highlights the city's progress in creating a safe and supportive environment for women.</li> <li>Index is given by Avatar group which focuses on inclusion, diversity and equity.</li> </ul> <p><b>About:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The city lags behind southern counterparts like Chennai and Bengaluru.</li> <li>The <b>city's inclusion score (CIS) of 39.58</b>, helped it bag the 4th position and Mumbai, Pune, Chennai and Bengaluru grabbed first 4 positions.</li> </ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hyderabad boasts a <b>relatively low crime rate against women</b> compared to other major Indian cities.</li> <li>The city has <b>implemented initiatives</b> like increased police patrolling, improved street lighting, and dedicated women's safety helplines to enhance security.</li> </ul>

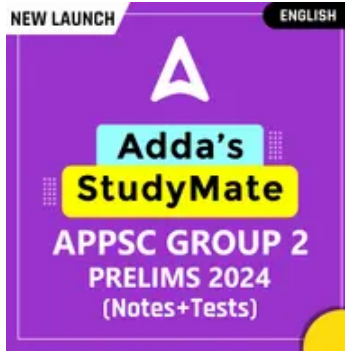
