Andhra Pradesh seeks ₹750 crore aid, raw material support	<ul> <li>Context:</li> <li>The Andhra Pradesh government has written to the Union Steel Ministry seeking financial support of ₹750 crore towards building infrastructure and improving connectivity around its proposed ₹8,800 crore greenfield steel plant in the YSR district of the state.</li> <li>The integrated steel plant plans, initially rejected by SAIL, are now being taken forward by Sajjan Jindal's JSW Group, the Andhra government wrote in a letter accessed by businessline.</li> <li>The state government has also sought help from the Centre to grant iron ore linkages for the steel plant and allocate such mines to the state's agency, AP Mineral Development Corporation Ltd.</li> </ul>




