National Deworming Day



Context:

- **National Deworming Day (NDD) is observed annually on February 10th in India**
- **It aims to make every child in the country "worm-free."**
- **It was launched in 2015, and the initiative targets children aged 1-19 years, both enrolled and non-enrolled in schools, through platforms like schools and Anganwadi centers.**
- **Theme of National Deworming Day 2024 is "Eliminate STH: Invest in a healthier future for children"**
- **It revolves around public health, with a specific focus on preventing and controlling parasitic worm infections, particularly in children**

Significance:

Reduces worm infections:

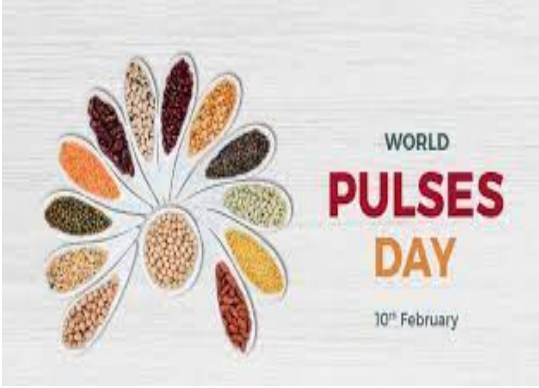
- **Soil-transmitted helminths (intestinal worms) are prevalent in India, leading to health issues like anemia, malnutrition, impaired cognitive development, and reduced school attendance. NDD tackles this by mass deworming children.**

Improves overall health:

- **By eliminating worms, NDD improves children's overall health, nutritional status, and quality of life, contributing to better educational outcomes and future potential.**

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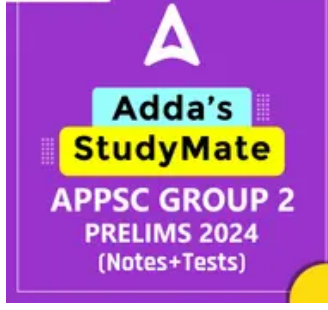
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
