SAS Infra's 'The Crown' in Hyderabad becomes South India's tallest tower	 Context: SAS Infra's ambitious residential project, 'The Crown,' has etched its name in the Hyderabad skyline as South India's tallest tower, proudly surpassing the 200-meter mark. It is the first project in South India to achieve such a towering height, further asserting its position as the tallest point in Hyderabad.
No TS college in NIRF top 50 list in past six years	 Context: Government and private medical colleges in TS have not featured in the top 50 in the National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) in the last six years. A total of 176 institutions participated in 2023 of which only four were from Telangana and none were government medical colleges. About: Established in 2015 by the Ministry of Education (MoE), NIRF aims to objectively rank higher educational institutions (HEIs) across various categories. Rankings are based on five comprehensive parameters: Teaching, Learning & Resources (TLR) Research and Professional Practice (RPC), Graduation Outcomes (GO) Outreach & Inclusivity (OI) Perception (PER).
